This project is intended for intermediate sewers that have a basic knowledge of sewing terms and techniques. These supplies will complete the entire quilt.

Finished size: 46" x 58"

Fabrics Needed:

Before you begin, pre-wash and iron your fabrics
40"-45" wide cotton fabrics:

- ¼ yard maroon batik
- 1 ¾ yards green leaf batik
- ¼ yard olive green batik (includes sashing squares)
- ¼ yard olive green leaf print
- 1/8 yard dark green batik
- ¼ yard light green print
- 3/8 yard pale green print
- 3/8 yard light blue leaf print
- ¼ yard light blue dot
- 3/8 yard pale blue texture
- ¼ yard light blue texture
- 1/8 yard dark blue tie dye
- ¼ yard dark aqua batik
- ¼ yard aqua tie dye
- 1/8 yard brown texture
- ¾ yard beige texture for sashing
- ¾ yard gold texture (includes ½ yard for binding)
- ¼ yard yellow texture
- 1/8 yard or scraps blue green tie dye, orange, peach, black, lavender and medium purple
- 2 ½ yards backing fabric

Materials Needed:

50" x 62" piece of Fairfield's Nature-fil™ Wool Batting
Thread to match fabrics
Invisible machine appliqué thread
Gold, white and black embroidery floss
Template plastic
24" x 18" piece freezer paper
½ yard paper backed fusible webbing

Tools Needed:

Sewing machine
Iron
Needles and pins
Scissors
Rotary cutter, Lucite ruler and Cutting mat
Ruler, pencil and water soluble pen
Plain paper - 8 ½" x 11 sheets
