

Flanged & Neckroll Pillow

Materials for Flanged Pillow:

- (1) 12" x 12" Soft Touch® Pillow form
- 3/4 yard striped fabric *(Pattern D071 Color 127)
- 3/8 yd all-over floral fabric *(Pattern D073 Color 450)
- 3/4 yard all-over print chain fabric *(Pattern D075 Color 127)
- 26" x 26" square poly-fil® Cotton Classic® batting
- (4) purchased tassels - 3" long
- Thread to match

Instructions:

*Note Use 1/2" seam allowance

1. From turquoise all-over floral fabric cut (1) 13" x 13" square. From red, turquoise and black stripe cut (4) pieces 8" x 27" long. Cut strip to leave a black stripe with red borders and seam allowance to one side of red floral stripe and (1) small red border plus seam allowance on other side. (Refer to pillow as example)
2. Attach one strip to each side of turquoise square with black stripe on inside. Sew with right sides together, mitering corners and matching stripes. Trim any excess beyond matched outer corners.
3. Baste pillow top at right side up to Cotton Classic batting. Machine quilt turquoise center in diagonal cross-hatch lines 1 1/2" apart. Outline stitch along each side of small red borders. Use a free hand serpentine stitch through the red floral stripe. Trim away excess batting.
4. For pillow backing, from remaining red all-over print chain, cut 2 pieces each 27" x 18". Along one 27" side, turn under a 1/4" seam. Press. Turn under 1/4" seam again. Press. Topstitch in place to finish raw edge. Repeat for remaining piece.
5. To assemble pillow cover, place quilted pillow top right side up. Place (1) piece of hemmed red print fabric right side down on pillow top. Hem should be in the middle of the pillow top. Repeat for remaining piece, overlapping hemmed edges. Stitch around outer edge of pillow top. Clip corners, turn. Press edges.
6. Topstitch pillow top on each side of large red floral stripe to create the quilted flanges. Attach one tassel in each inside corner of the flange as shown in finished pillow.
7. Insert pillow form through the lapped back.

Materials for Neckroll Pillow:

- (1) 14" x 5" Soft Touch® neckroll pillow form
- 1/8 yard all-over black floral *(Pattern D077 Color 055)
- 5/8 yard striped fabric *(Pattern D071 Color 127)
- 1 1/8 yard 1 1/4" wide metallic paisley ribbon -Gallant Pattern # 15-5855 Color comb 3 burgundy by C.M. Offray and Son, Inc.
- 1 3/8 yard 1 1/2" wide wire-edge taffeta ribbon - pattern 6101 color 277 by C.M. Offray and Son, Inc.
- 10 small roses (1 pkg) pattern #10-2019 color 275 burgundy by C.M. Offray and Son, Inc.
- (6) pre-made fabric or silk floral leaves
- 1 1/8 yard gold and black premade piping
- Thread to match
- Hand sewing needle

Instructions:

*Note: use 1/2" seam allowance

1. Cut striped fabric 15" wide by 20" long. Center the large red floral stripe in the middle of the 15" width
2. Cut (2) pieces from black floral each 4" wide by 20" long
3. Cut piping in half. Baste one piece to each 20" end of striped fabric. Allow for 1/2" seam allowance.
4. With right sides together, sew black floral fabric to each end of striped fabric. Use basting stitches of piping as a sewing guide to get a tight seam for the piping.
5. Cut "Gallant" paisley ribbon in half. Center one piece on turquoise print of striped fabric. Top stitch in place. Repeat for other side.
6. With right sides together, match stripes, piping, etc. and sew center back seam. Leave a 10" opening in the center for inserting the pillow form.
7. Using a hand sewing needle and a double length of thread. Run a gathering stitch around open end of pillow. Pull tightly to gather. Knot off. Secure stitches with some extra stitches across gathers to hold closed. Knot off again.
8. Turn pillow cover to right side. Insert pillow and run gathering stitch as described in step # 7.
9. To make ribbon rose, cut burgundy taffeta ribbon in half. Take one length, tie a knot in one end. At opposite end, gently push wire out of end on one side. Gather ribbon tightly along wire. Starting at the knot, gently wrap gathered ribbon around knot. Secure with exposed wire. Trim excess wire and gently crush rose in palm of hand for a vintage look. Repeat process for second rose.
10. To complete pillow, attach 3 silk leaves to the center of each gathered end of the pillow. Attach rose in center of leaves at each end.
11. Attach (5) small roses evenly spaced throughout small black floral stripe.



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
