

Pattern by: Tricia T. Santamaria

Materials/Supplies Needed:

- Four 25"x25" pieces of duck cloth or canvas
- 1 yd. each of blue and red duck cloth
- Red, white, blue and yellow water resistant craft paint
- Two 1" in diameter wooden dowels approx 2 feet in length
- Two blocks of ply wood 8"x 8" x 1/2"
- Two 2" flat head nails
- Six 2lb. bags of Poly-fil® poly-pellets®
- Mashing tape, thread, paint brushes, hammer, utility knife

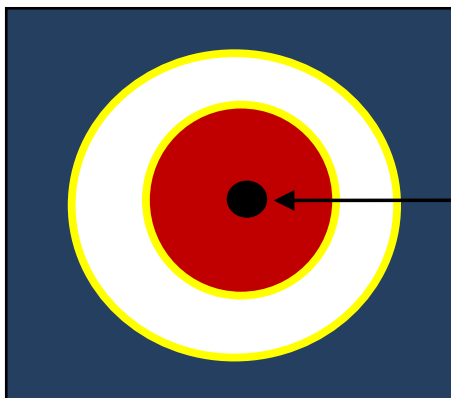
Paint white on one side of each 25" x 25" piece of duck cloth to prep and seal.



Cutting Instructions:

For Bulls-eye (Dia. #1)

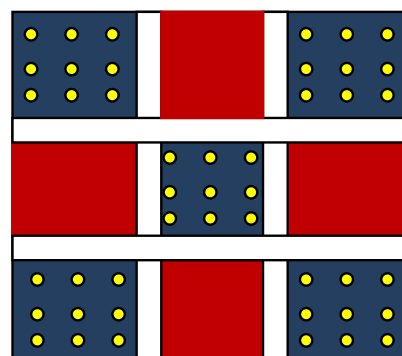
- Trace the circle pattern on painted side of two pieces of duck cloth. (I traced around different size bowls to make mine)
- Paint the red circle first then the blue outer portion and outline with bright yellow.
- You will need to mark out a 1 1/2 inch diameter circle (shown in black) in the center for the dowel hole.

Cut after all sewing

- Paint alternating red and blue squares and add yellow dots (if desired) when blue paint dries.
- After all paint has dried remove tape.
- Fold the edges under 1/2" on all pieces.
- Pair one bulls-eye piece with the tic tac toe piece with wrong sides together and top stitch edges leaving a 5" opening.



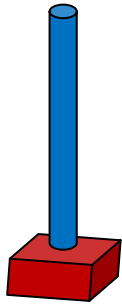

- bulls eye piece with the white piece again wrong sides together and top stitch around edges leaving 5 inch opening. Stitch around center bulls-eye hole.
- Add two bags of pellets to each and stitch closed.
- Cut inside the stitching of center holes so you can place the pad over the dowel. (I used a utility knife)

For tic tac toe (Dia. #2)

- On the painted side of another piece of duck cloth tape off squares with masking or painters tape as shown in white.

-Paint dowels and blocks in any color you want and nail blocks to bottom of dowels. (Dia. #3)



Dia. #3

-Cut out four red and four blue horseshoes using attached template.
-Stitch together leaving an opening to fill with pellets. Then add pellets and stitch closed.

For Tossing Stars:

-Cut out 10 each red and blue stars using attached template. Sew together leaving an opening to fill with pellets. Then add pellets and stitch closed.
