

Little Nine-Patch Doll Quilt

Finished Quilt: 14" x 18"

Finished Block: 3" x 3"

Materials:

Assorted scraps of pink, green, brown and shirting prints

1/4 yard of a light shirting print

1/4 yard of a brown print

1/8 yard of a pink print

5/8 yard of backing fabric

1/4 yard of a green print for binding

18" x 22" piece of Fairfield 100% cotton batting

Cutting

From the assorted scrap prints, cut

4 matching squares, 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" (24 total)

1 contrasting print square, 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" (6 total)

From the assorted light or shirting print scraps, cut

4 matching squares, 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" (24 total)

From the light shirting print, cut

1 square, 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" cut twice on the diagonal to yield 4 setting triangles

2 setting squares, 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"

2 squares, 3" x 3" cut once diagonally to yield 4 corner triangles

From the brown print, cut

2 strips, 3" x 8 3/4"

2 strips, 3" x 12 3/4"

From the pink print, cut

4 squares, 3" x 3"

From the green print for binding, cut

2 strips, 1 1/2" x 42"

Make the Quilt

1. For each nine-patch block, arrange four matching medium print 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" squares, four matching light print or shirting 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" squares and one contrasting 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" square for the center. Sew the pieces into rows, pressing the seams of the top and bottom rows toward the corner squares and the seams of the middle row toward the center square. Sew the rows together and press the seams toward the center. Make 6 blocks from the different prints.

2. Using the quilt diagram as a guide, arrange the blocks, setting triangles and corner triangles in a diagonal set. Join the pieces in diagonal rows. Press the blocks toward the setting triangles.



3. Trim the quilt top, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.

4. Measure the length of the quilt through the center. Sew the 3" x 12 3/4" brown print strips to fit the sides of the quilt. Press seams toward the border.



5. Sew a 3" x 3" pink print square to both ends of the 3" x 8 3/4" brown strips. Add these pieces to the top and the bottom of the quilt.



Finish the Quilt

1. Layer the quilt top, batting and backing, and pin or baste the layers together.
2. Quilt an X in each block and in the border corner blocks. Quilt a 1" crosshatch design in the background.
3. Attach the binding to the quilt using a 1 1/2" single-fold binding.
