Materials/Supplies Needed:

- Small children's socks
- Fairfield Poly-Pellets® weighted stuffing beads
- Fairfield Poly-fil® 100% premium polyester fiberfill
- Elastic bands
- Fabric markers
- Fabric glue

Optional supplies:

- Ribbon
- Felt
- Glitter glue
- Fabric paint
- Fabric scraps



Instructions:

You can experiment with the amount of fiber you use to make different shapes and sizes of snow people.

1. Fill the bottom of the sock with about 1/3 cup of Poly-Pellets® weighted stuffing beads and two or three handfuls of Poly-fil® fiberfill.
2. Tie the sock closed with string or secure with an elastic band.
3. Add one or two handfuls of Poly-fil® fiberfill to the next section and secure.
4. Repeat for the top section.
5. Fold over the top of the sock to form the hat.
6. For the small snow people just turn the sock inside out and tie a knot at the bottom. Turn right side out and repeat directions above eliminating the middle section.
7. Now decorate with ribbon, paint, glitter glue, fabric, etc. You can cut some felt or fabric to make a scarf or wrap some ribbon around to make a skirt. Add buttons and beads. Use whatever you have in your stash.
8. Lastly, use a fabric marker to draw the faces and you're done.
