



Poly-Fil® Supreme Ultra Plush Bear

Template pieces are actual size

Finished Size: 9" tall

Materials:

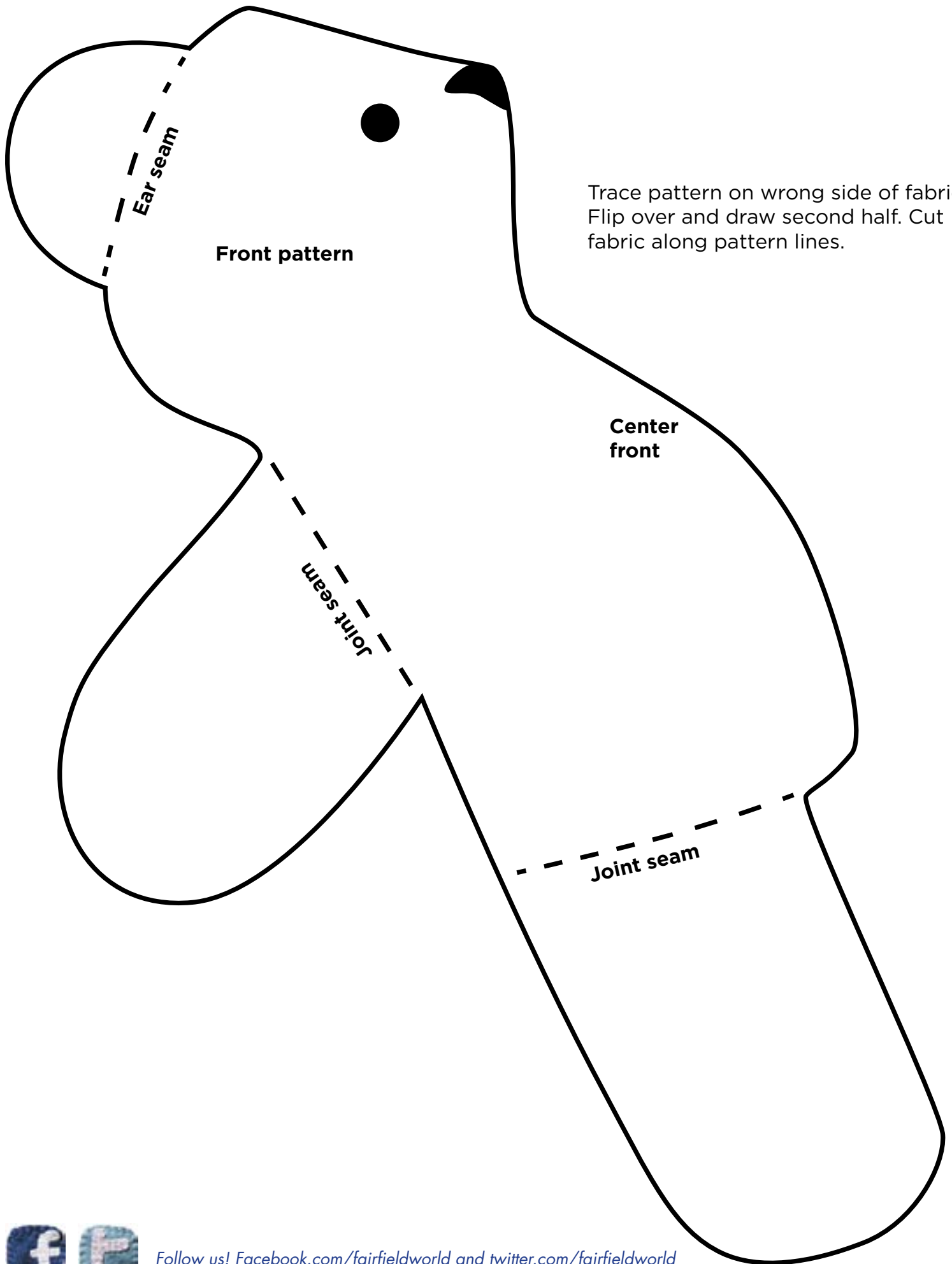
- 1/4 yard fur-type fabric
- Two 15mm animal eyes or buttons
- One 21mm animal nose or black embroidery floss
- Black embroidery floss for mouth and eyebrows
- Ultra Plush Poly-Fil Supreme® fiberfill
- Matching thread
- Ribbon: 5/8" wide x 22" long
- Sewing supplies
- Cardboard



Directions:

Pattern calls for 1/4" seam allowance unless otherwise noted.

1. Trace pattern pieces onto cardboard, cut out and trace onto back side of fabric. Flip pattern pieces and trace again. You will need two fronts and two backs.
2. With right sides together, pin body front pieces together and machine sew. Repeat with back sections leaving back opening as marked. Clip curves.
3. Insert animal eyes and nose. (Skip if eyes and nose will be embroidered.)
4. With right sides together, pin body front to back and sew all around. Turn right sides out.
5. Stitch ear seams as marked on pattern.
6. Stuff head with fiberfill. Use a stuffing tool to fill muzzle and small areas.
7. Tie off the neck with strong thread.
8. Stuff arms and legs. Stitch joints as marked on pattern.
9. Stuff body cavity.
10. Hand sew opening closed using a ladder stitch. Pick trapped fur from seams (a new toothbrush works well)
11. Embroider facial features using black floss as desired.
12. Tie ribbon around the bear's neck.
