Materials/Supplies Needed: One skein of each, medium: Worsted-Weight Wool

- Brown
- Burnt Orange
- Oatmeal
- Burgundy
- Light Blue
- Yellow
- Red
- Blue
- Green
- Beige
- Pink

Poly-fil Premium[®] fiberfill Crochet Hook—Size 4.00mm Split Ring Stitch Markers Embroidery Needle Wool Felt Scrap—Black and Red Aleene's® Fabric Fusion[™] Permanent Dry Cleanable Fabric Adhesive[™]

Abbreviations:

sc= single crochet
st= stitch
dec= decrease
rnd= round(s)
sl st= slip stitch
hdc= half double crochet
dc= double crochet
*= repeat instructions following the single asterisk as directed

Tips & Notes

- Rounds are worked in continuous spirals; do not join. Do not turn work at the end of each round.
- Crochet into both front and back of each stitch.
- Time saving finishing tip—when changing yarn colors crochet around the yarn ends, this way you won't have to weave the ends into the form when finishing the rabbit.

Instructions:

Body With Brown, chain 2.



Rnd 1: 5 sc in second chain from hook. Mark first sc for beg of rnd; move marker up each rnd. Rnd 2: 2 sc in each sc (10) Rnd 3: 2 sc in each sc (20) Change to Burnt Orange Rnd 4: *Sc in next 1sc, work 2 sc in the next sc; repeat from * (30) Rnd 5: Sc in each sc Change to Oatmeal Rnd 6: Sc in each sc Rnd 7: *Sc in next 2sc, work 2 sc in the next sc; repeat from * (40) Rnd 8: Sc in each sc Change to Burgundy Rnd 9-11: Sc in each sc Change to Light Blue Rnd 12: *Sc in next 3sc, work 2 sc in the next sc; repeat from * (50) Rnd 13-14: Sc in each sc Change to Yellow Rnd 15-17: Sc in each sc Change to Red Rnd 18-20: Sc in each sc Change to Blue Rnd 21-23: Sc in each sc Change to Green 24-26: Sc in each sc Change to Beige Rnd 27: *Sc in next 3sc, dec 1 in the next sc; repeat from * (40) Rnd 28-29: Sc in each sc Change to Pink Rnd 30-32: Sc in each sc Change to Burnt Orange Rnd 33-35: Sc in each sc Change to Oatmeal Rnd 36: Sc in next 2sc, dec 1 in the next sc; repeat from * (30) Rnd 37-38: Sc in each sc Change to Burgundy Rnd 39: Sc in next 1sc, dec 1 in the next sc; repeat from * (20) Rnd 40-41: Sc in each sc Stuff. Change to Light Blue Rnd 42-44: Sc in each sc Change to Yellow Rnd 45-47: Sc in each sc Stuff, fasten off, and leave a tail for sewing.

Legs (make 2)

Reminder Note: Crocheting is done in the round. However, heel shaping you turn the piece between rows,

With Brown, chain 2.
Rnd 1: 5 sc in second chain from hook. Mark first sc for beg of rnd; move marker up each rnd.
Rnd 2: 2 sc in each sc (10)
Rnd 3: 2 sc in each sc (20) *Change to Burnt Orange*Rnd: 4-5: Sc in each sc *Change to Oatmeal*Rnd: 6-7: Sc in each sc *Change to Burgundy*Rnd: 8-9: Sc in each sc

Change to Light Blue Rnd: 10-11: Sc in each sc *Change to Yellow* Rnd: 12-13: Sc in each sc *Change to Red*

Shape Heel

To shape the heel, turn leg between rows.

Rnd 14: sc in next st, hdc in next st, dc in each of next 5 dc, hdc in next sc, sc in next st, sl st in next st. Turn.

Rnd 15: Next Row: Sc in sc, hdc in hdc, dc in each dc, hdc in hdc, sc in sc, sl st in next st, turn.

Change to Blue

Rnd 16- 17: Repeat rnd 15 twice more.

Change to Yellow

Instead of changing yarn color in the standard way by pulling the yellow yarn through the last loop of the last stitch done in blue, sl st with the yellow yarn into a yellow st that was done prior to doing the heel shaping.

Rnd 18-19: (Crocheting into the stitches that were done to create the heel shape) Sc in sc from the previous round and sl st at the end of each row in preparation for continuing to work the stripe pattern.

Change to Red.

Rnd 20-21: Sc in each sc (20 sc)

Continue working two rounds of single crochet for each of the following colors:

Rnd 22-23: Blue, Rnd 24-25: Green, Rnd 26-27: Beige, Rnd 28-29: Pink, Rnd 30-31: Burnt Orange, Rnd 32-33: Oatmeal, Rnd 34-35 Burgundy, Rnd 36-37: Light Blue, Rnd 38-39: Yellow, Rnd 40-41: Red

Stuff.

Change to Blue

Rnd 42: *Sc in the next 3 sc, dec 1 in the next sc; repeat from* (16) Rnd 43: *Sc in the next 2 sc, dec 1 in the next sc; repeat from* (12) Crochet the leg closed. The seam should be paralleled with the foot.

Arms (make 2)

With Brown, chain 2. Rnd 1: 5 sc in second chain from hook. Mark first sc for beg of rnd; move marker up each rnd. Rnd 2: 2sc in each sc (10) Rnd 3: 2sc in each sc (20) Change to Burnt Orange Rnd: 4-5: Sc in each sc Change to Oatmeal Rnd: 6-7: Sc in each sc Change to Burgundy Rnd: 8-9: Sc in each sc Change to Light Blue Rnd 10-11: Sc in each sc Change to Yellow Rnd 12-13: Sc in each sc Change to Red Rnd 14-15: Sc in each sc Change to Blue Rnd 16-17: Sc in each sc Change to Green Rnd 18-19: Sc in each sc Change to Beige Rnd 20-21: Sc in each sc Change to Pink

Rnd 22-23: Sc in each sc *Change to Burnt Orange*

Rnd 24-25: Sc in each sc

Change to Oatmeal Rnd 26: *Sc in next 2sc, dec 1 in the next sc; repeat from * (15) Rnd 27: Sc in each sc Change to Burgundy Rnd 28-30: Sc in each sc Change to Light Blue Stuff Rnd 31: *Sc in next 3sc, dec 1 in the next sc; repeat from* (12) Rnd 32-33: Sc in each sc Change to Yellow Rnd 34: *Sc in next 2sc, dec 1 in the next sc; repeat from* (9) Rnd 35: Sc in each sc

Fasten off and leave a tail for sewing.

Head

With pink yarn, chain 2. Rnd 1: 5 sc in second chain from hook. Mark first sc for beg of rnd; move marker up each rnd. Rnd 2: 2sc in each sc (10) Rnd 3: *Sc in next 1 sc, work 2 sc in the next sc; repeat from* (15) Rnd 4: *Sc in next 2 sc, work 2 sc in the next sc; repeat from* (20) Rnd 5: *Sc in next 3 sc, work 2 sc in the next sc; repeat from* (25) Rnd 6: *Sc in next 4 sc, work 2 sc in the next sc; repeat from* (30) Rnd 7: *Sc in next 5 sc, work 2 sc in the next sc; repeat from* (35) Rnd 8-13: Sc in each sc Change to Blue Rnd 14: *Sc in the next 6sc, work 2 sc in the sc; repeat from* (40) Rnd 15-16: Sc in each sc Change to Green Rnd 17-20: Sc in each sc Change to Beige Rnd 21-23: Sc in each sc Change to Burnt Orange Rnd 24-26: Sc in each sc Change to Oatmeal Rnd 27: *Sc in the next 6 sc, dec 1 in the next sc; repeat from* (35) Rnd 28: *Sc in the next 5 sc, dec 1 in the next sc; repeat from* (30) Rnd 29: *Sc in the next 4 sc, dec 1 in the next sc; repeat from* (25) Rnd 30: *Sc in the next 3 sc, dec 1 in the next sc; repeat from* (20) Rnd 31: *Sc in the next 2 sc, dec 1 in the next sc; repeat from* (15) Stuff. Rnd 32: *Sc in the next 1 sc, dec 1 in the next sc; repeat from* (10) Rnd 33: Dec in each sc Fasten off. Weave closed the opening if need be. Weave in the end of the yarn.

Ears (make 2)

With Oatmeal yarn, chain 2. Rnd 1: 6 sc in second chain from hook. Mark first sc for beg of rnd; move marker up each rnd. Rnd 2: Sc in each sc *Change to Burnt Orange* Rnd 3 *Sc in next 1sc, work 2 sc in the next sc; repeat from * (9 sc) Rnd 4: Sc in each sc *Change to Burgundy* Rnd 7: *Sc in next 2sc, work 2 sc in the next sc; repeat from * (12 sc) Rnd 8: *Sc in next 3sc, work 2 sc in the next sc; repeat from * (15 sc) *Change to Pink* Rnd 9-10: Sc in each sc *Change to Red* Rnd 11: *Sc in next 4sc, work 2sc in the next sc; repeat from* (18 sc) Rnd 12: Sc in each sc *Change to Blue* Rnd 13: *Sc in next 5sc, work 2sc in the next sc; repeat from* (21sc) Rnd 14: Sc in each sc *Change to Green* Rnd 15- 16: Sc in each sc **Continue working two rounds of single crochet for each of the following colors:** Beige, Pink, Burnt Orange, Light Blue, Burgundy, Oatmeal, Yellow, Red and Blue

Fasten off and leaving a long tail for sewing to head.

Note: The ears do not get filled which impacts the appearance and size. Pulling the ears lengthwise is how to make the adjustment and have consistency with the rest of the design.

Finishing

Using photo for reference, attach parts by sewing

- 1. Head to body
- 2. An arm on each side of body—align the yellow row of the arms with the middle of the yellow row of the body
- 3. Legs to sides of body—align top of leg seam with the bottom of the red stripe
- 4. Sew ears to head

Create and apply face details

- 1. Cut triangle from red felt and glue to face.
- 2. Cut two circles from black felt for the eyes and glue to face.
