Flower Garden Placemats

Each placemat has pocket for napkin and flatware. Follow the directions for ironing on fusible webbing and Fairfield's FUSI-BOO™ batting. This quick and easy project uses the flip and sew method to put placemats together. Finished placemats are 13″x19″

Supplies (for 4 placemats)

- 1 yd white for background
- 1¼ yd green (includes binding)
- 9" x 9" pink square
- 9" x 9" lavender square
- 4" x 8" yellow rectangle
- ½ yd paper-back fusible webbing
- 1 yd backing fabric
- 36" x 46" craft size Fairfield FUSI-BOO™ batting

<u>Cut</u> (for 4 placemats)

From background fabric

12 - 5½" x 13½" rectangles

4 – 5½" x 5" rectangles

From green fabric

 $4 - \frac{1}{2}$ " x 11" bias strips (for stems)

8 – 2½" x 13½" strips

4 - 5½" x 5½" squares

8 - 21/4" strips (WOF) for binding

From backing fabric

4 - 14" x 20" rectangles

From Fairfield Fusi-Boo batting

4 - 14" x 20" rectangles


Pocket construction

1. Sew 5½" x 5½" green square to 5½" x 5" background rectangle, right sides together. See Figure 1.

- 2. Iron seam toward green.
- 3. Fold green down, wrong sides together, matching bottom edges. About ¼" green will extend above top of white. See Figure 2.



4. Press. Lay aside.

Appliqué Flowers

- 1. Trace 2 flowers, 2 centers, 3 leaves, bud and calyx onto paperback fusible webbing. Leave at least ¼" between each piece.
- 2. Cut out pieces at least 1/8" beyond lines.
- 3. Iron pieces onto wrong side of fabric 1 pink flower, 1 pink bud, 1 lavender flower, 2 yellow centers, 3 green leaves and 1 green calyx.
- 4. Iron bias stem strip in half lengthwise, wrong sides together.
- 5. Lay one white $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $13\frac{1}{2}$ " background rectangle, right side up, on top of pattern. Lightly trace stem guide line onto fabric. NOTE: Line up top of background rectangle with top of appliqué pattern. Stem extends down behind the pocket 2"-3".
- 6. Center bias strip on line. Sew down center.
- 7. Trim raw edge of seam 1/8".
- 8. Press stem over and machine appliqué using blanket stitch or other appliqué stitch of your choice. *You may want to stitch down both sides*.
- 9. Place appliqué pattern on ironing board with the background rectangle on top of it. Lay pieces in place. Press.
- 10. Place pattern for pocket on ironing board and pocket on top of it. Position flower and leaf on fabric. Press in place. *There is no stem on pocket*.
- 11. Machine appliqué flowers on background rectangle and pocket. NOTE: Appliqué through green pocket backing.
- 12. Repeat Steps 1 11 three times.

Assemble

Directions use flip and sew method for assembly and quilting. However, you can sew top together; then, fuse backing, batting and top together and quilt.

- 1. Lay your batting on top of Appliqué Pressing Sheet or parchment paper on ironing board.
- 2. Place backing, wrong side down, on top of **Fairfield Fusi-Boo™** batting. Press in place. *Keep batting on pressing sheet or parchment paper*.
- 3. Turn batting/backing over and lay appliqué flower panel along left edge, right side up, on top of batting. Press in place being careful not to iron directly on batting.
- 4. Quilt appliqué panel at this point.
- 5. Lay pocket flat on appliqué panel. Pin along bottom and sides.
- 6. Lay 2½" x 13½" green strip, right side down, along right edge of white panel.
- 7. Stitch in place. Flip green strip and press being careful not to iron directly on batting.
- 8. Lay white panel on right edge of green strip. Stitch in place.
- 9. Flip white panel over and press in place.
- 10. Repeat steps 6 through 9.
- 11. Add additional quilting at this time.
- 12. Trim to 13" x 19".
- 13. Bind.
