

Suggested Cutting and Sewing Instructions Long Faux Fur

Cutting- When cutting long faux furs it's best to cut the back material only. This will allow the fur to remain long and omit short blunt uneven ends.



Step A
Select a sharp pair of scissors. We used Fiskars Razor Edge 8".

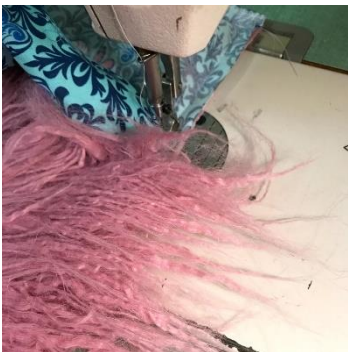


Step B
Cut the furs base material only. Begin by separating the fur where the cut will be made. Lift the scissor up against the fur base to cut.



Step C
Gently pull the two pieces of fur apart after cutting. There will be some cut fur. Remove by gently pulling out.

Sewing- To sew long faux fur brush the fur to inside the seam with your hand. Place material over the fur. Pin in place then sew.



Step D
Do not sew across long faux fur. Fur will be sewn in and leave a short-folded edge.



Step E
Do tuck the fur inside when sewing. Pin fabric onto the fur (right side together) and sew. Leave opening for pillow to be inserted.



Step F
Turn right sides out. Note how long the fur is at the seams. Fluff fur by shaking. Fur will fall into place.
